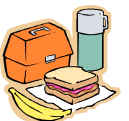
PARKING LOT CLOSED ON ISSAQUAH CAMPUS

- 8th grade- hand sanitizers/wipes

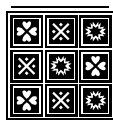
