Registration for Returning Students & their Siblings is due Friday, February 17.

Please return the registration forms even if your student is not returning for next year.

We will accept no late returning student registrations this year. If you return your returning student registration after February 17, you will lose your priority as a returning student and join the pool of new student applications. If you return your registration after February 17, be sure to include the \$25 new student application fee for each student with your registration fees.

Configuration decisions will be made based on the number of registrations we have received on February 17. There may not be room for new students at some grade levels, so get your registrations in!

What you need to return:

- Returning Registration form(s) (one per student)
- Signed Registration Contract
- Signed Tuition and Fundraising Agreement
- Registration Fees:
 - \$75 per student registration fee AND
 - ½ of the July Tuition Payment for each student.
- If you are applying for a student who will be new to St. Joseph school but is a sibling of a current student, please also complete a **new student application** for that student and include the **\$25.00 new student application fee** in addition to \$75 registration fee and ½ July tuition payment for that student. New student applications are available on the website or from the Issaquah office. If you have any questions about what to return or what your registration fee amount is, please call Lynn or Carol in the business office: 425-313-9129, x 323.

Note for siblings entering Kindergarten:

If, in addition to your older returning students, you have a child entering Kindergarten you will need to complete a new student application for your new Kindergarten applicant. If you did not receive one with your registration materials, please request one from the school office, or get on on-line at the school website. In addition to the registration fee and half July tuition for this student, please also include the new student application fee of \$25.00 – but just for the new kindergarten applicant. Please submit the new student application, the returning student registration forms, the signed Registration Contract and the signed Tuition and Fundraising Agreement, with the required fees to the office by February 17. When you have submitted your kindergarten application, call the Issaquah office to sign up for a Kindergarten Assessment appointment. All students entering Kindergarten are assessed for readiness; the Assessments take place on FRIDAY, March 24.
