## REGISTRATION POLICY

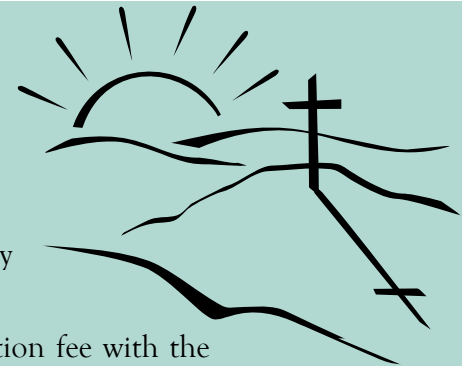
Priority for admission will be given to families who regularly participate in the parish through participation in liturgy, stewardship of time and talent, and stewardship of treasure.

A deposit is to be paid at the time of registration. This deposit includes a registration fee with the balance applied to the tuition amount. A materials fee will be added to your tuition amount.
